Ba Zheng Pian - 60370

八正片

Ingredients:

Bian Xu (Herba Polygoni Avicularis)

Che Qian Zi (Semen Plantaginas)

Da Huang (Radix Et Rhizoma Rhei)

Gan Cao (Radix Glycyrrhizae)

Huang Qin (Radix Scutellariae)

Jin Qian Cao (Herba Lysimachiae)

Qu Mai (Herba Dianthi)

Zhi Zi (Fructus Gardeniae)

Fu Liao (Amlyum)

Actions: Clearing Heat and purging Fire;
Promoting urination and dispelling Dampness.

Indications: Urination disturbance due to down flow or dampness, and Heat, marked by frequent, urgent, or difficult and painful urination, or retention of urine, distention and fullness in the lower abdomen, dry mouth and throat, red tongue with yellowfish and greasy coating, rapid and slippery pulse.

Applications: Disorders with the above-mentioned symptoms as cystitis, urethritis, acute prostatitis, and stones in the urine system and pyelonephritis.

Indications: Syndrome due to deficiency of Qi and Blood, marked By pale or sallow complexion, shortness of breath, languor, lassitude, loss of appetite, dizziness, palpitation, pale tongue with a thin whitish coating thin and weak pulse.

Applications: Diseases with the above-mentioned symptoms as anemia, leukaemia, and various chronic diseases.

Indication: Dysentery due to toxic Heat, marked by abdominal Pain, bloody stool with pus, tenesmus, burning sensation

around the anus, fever, thirst, red tongue with yellowish, coating, wiry and rapid pulse.

Application: Diseases with the above-mentioned symptoms as Acute bacillary dysentery, amebic dysentery, acute enteritis, hepatic Abscess, acute conjunctivitis, which due to down-flow of Damp-Heat in the Large Intestine and Blood stage (Xue)

Application: Diseases with the above-mentioned symptoms as Sequel of cerebrovascular accident, sequel of poliomyelitis and Paralysis due to other causes.
